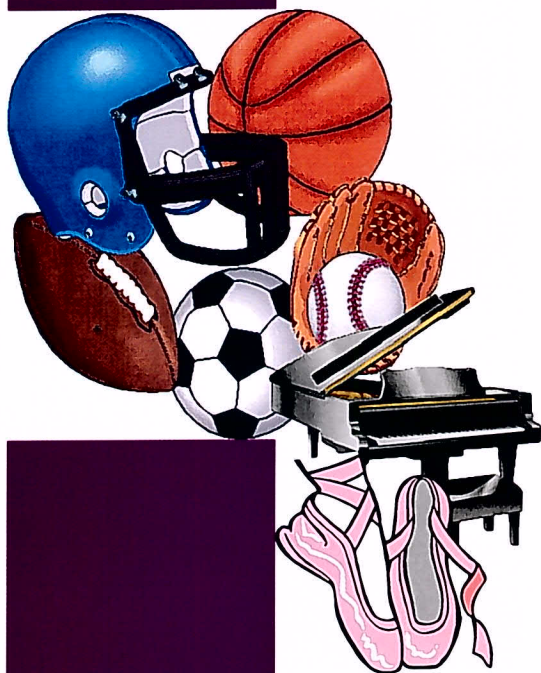


# District Child Recreational Assistance Program

## Who Can Apply?

Low-income families with children under 18 years of age who:

- are unable to afford registration fees for various recreational and cultural children's programs and;
- are not currently participating in another registered program and;
- are a resident of either a rural member municipality or an unincorporated areas within the designated service area of The District of Thunder Bay Social Services Administration Board (other than the City of Thunder Bay).



## How Do I Apply?

- Choose a community-based program of interest to your child.
- Contact your nearest Ontario Works office for a District Child Recreational Assistance Program Application Form.
